As we work in a disciplined way with the Holy Spirit's guidance and with the covering of our prayer partners we know God's close-



Current Therapy situation at SALT

Skills Sessions courses are not able to run through October & November due to the current pandemic situation. We are possibly looking at running these in early part of 2021 with reduced numbers per group.

We have 33 ladies on our waiting list due to the above.

Eighteen ladies are currently receiving their listening sessions either by phone, Skype or Face to Face, having already completed the skills course pre—lockdown Only 5 ladies are waiting for two of our listeners to become available for them to start individual therapy sessions.
